Improvements are coming

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements to the following streets in the Maple area:

- Greenock Drive
- Whitburn Crescent

The City of Vaughan will be installing new Oil and Grit Separator (OGS) units within the storm sewer system, as part of the 2023 Capital Works Program. The OGS units are similar to storm maintenance holes and are a key part of the City's stormwater infrastructure.

Project update

The City has completed Phase 2 of the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund – Oil and Grit Separator Program. The next phase, which is the tendering process to retain a contractor, is expected to be completed this month.

Construction scope

The scope of work includes the installation of OGS units and related stormwater infrastructure within paved roadway areas. Watermain adjustments may be required to accommodate the installations. All temporary water disruptions will be communicated in advance directly to the impacted residents.



Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary diversions or detours will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.

Construction is scheduled to begin summer 2023 and is anticipated to be complete by fall 2023.
