BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 132-2022

A By-law to amend the Administrative Monetary Penalties By-law 063-2019, as amended, to include the Sewer Use By-law 130-2022.

WHEREAS section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly as to confer broad authority on a municipality to enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS section 11(2)(8) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, states that a municipality may pass by-laws to protect persons and property;

AND WHEREAS section 434.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality may require a person to pay an Administrative Monetary Penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person has failed to comply with a by-law of the municipality passed under the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS Council has approved that the Sewer Use By-law contain administrative monetary penalties, penalties which are less punitive than provincial fines, providing staff with an additional enforcement tool.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In Administrative Monetary Penalties By-law 063-2019, as amended, add the following row to the table in Schedule 1 – Designated By-laws:
