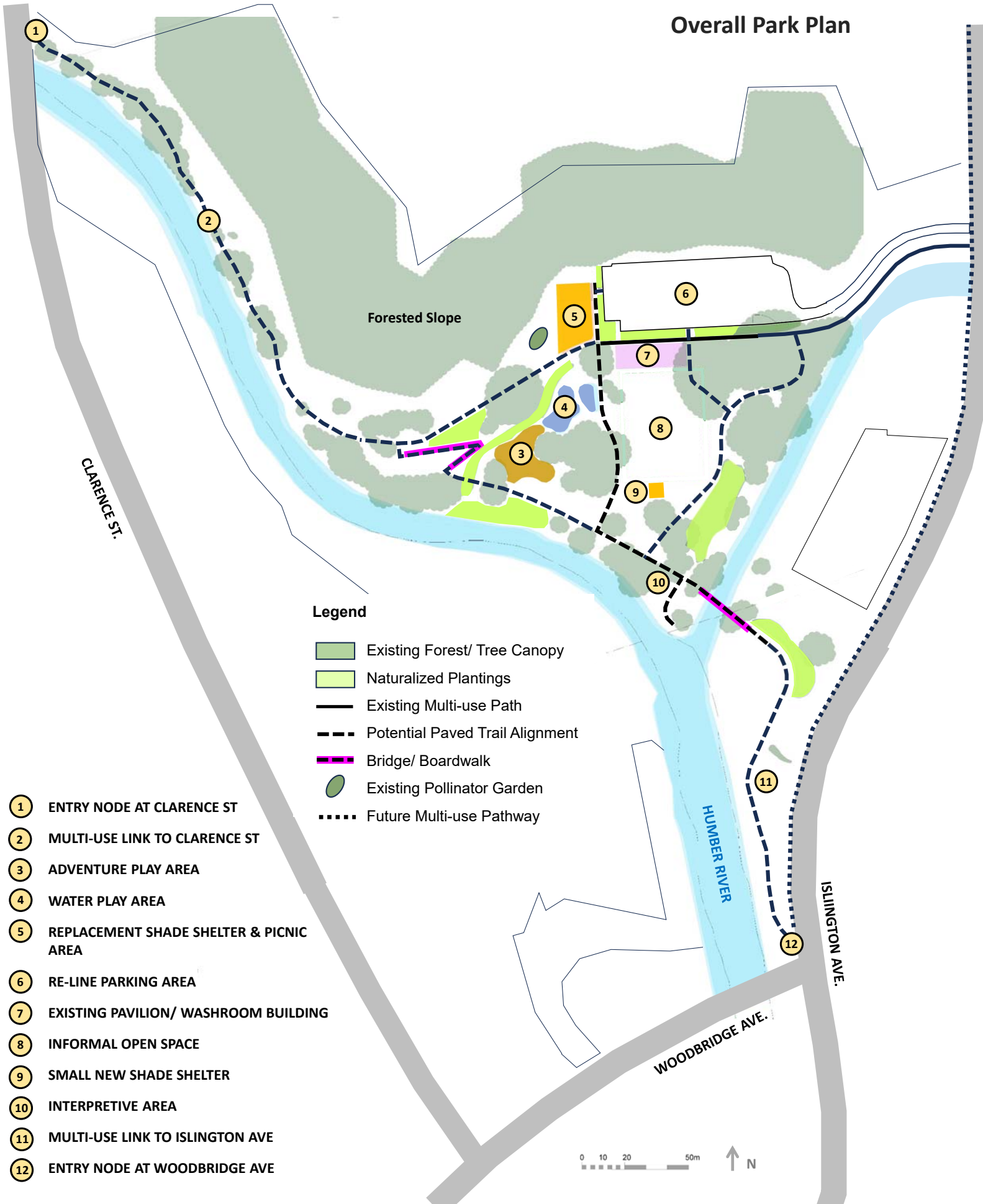


# Overall Park Plan

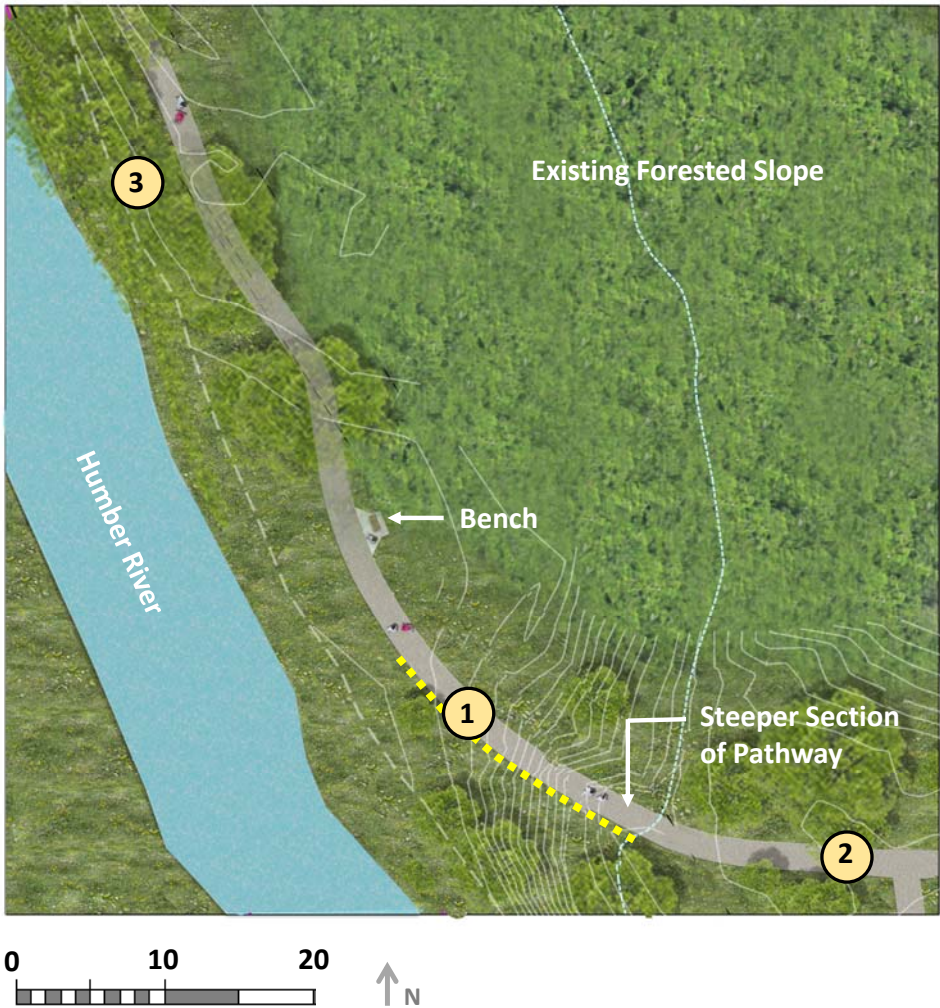

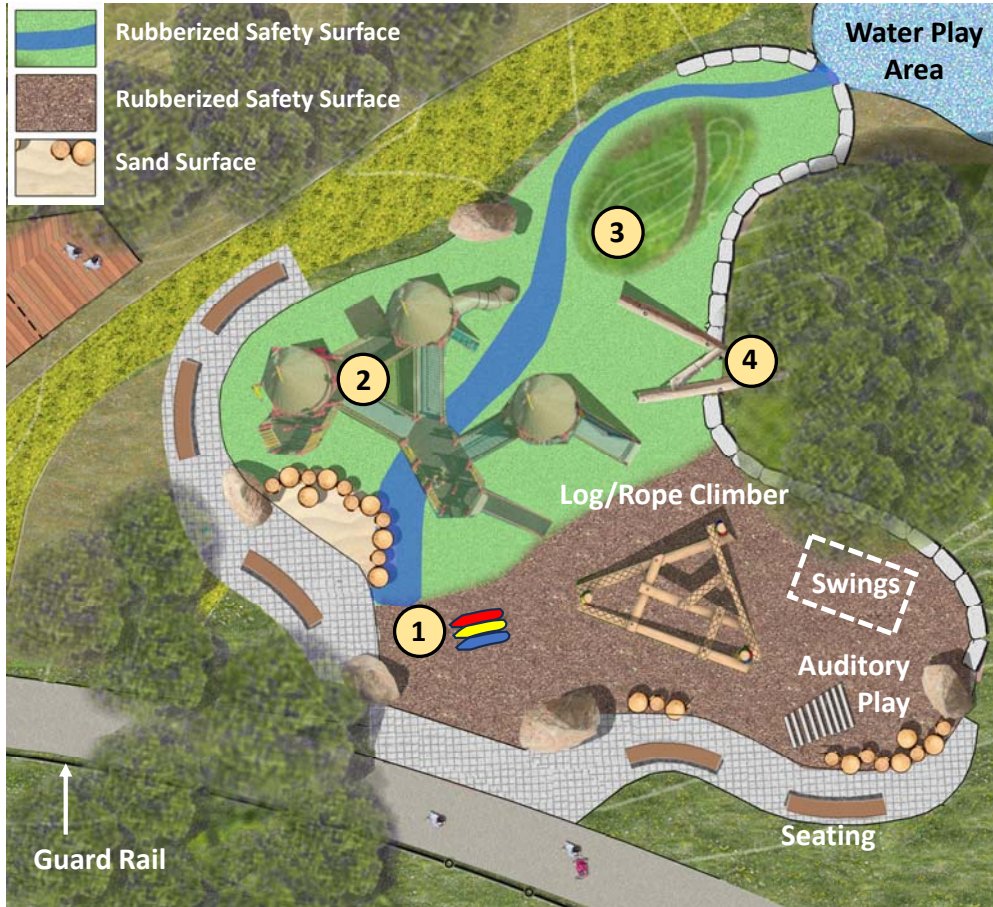

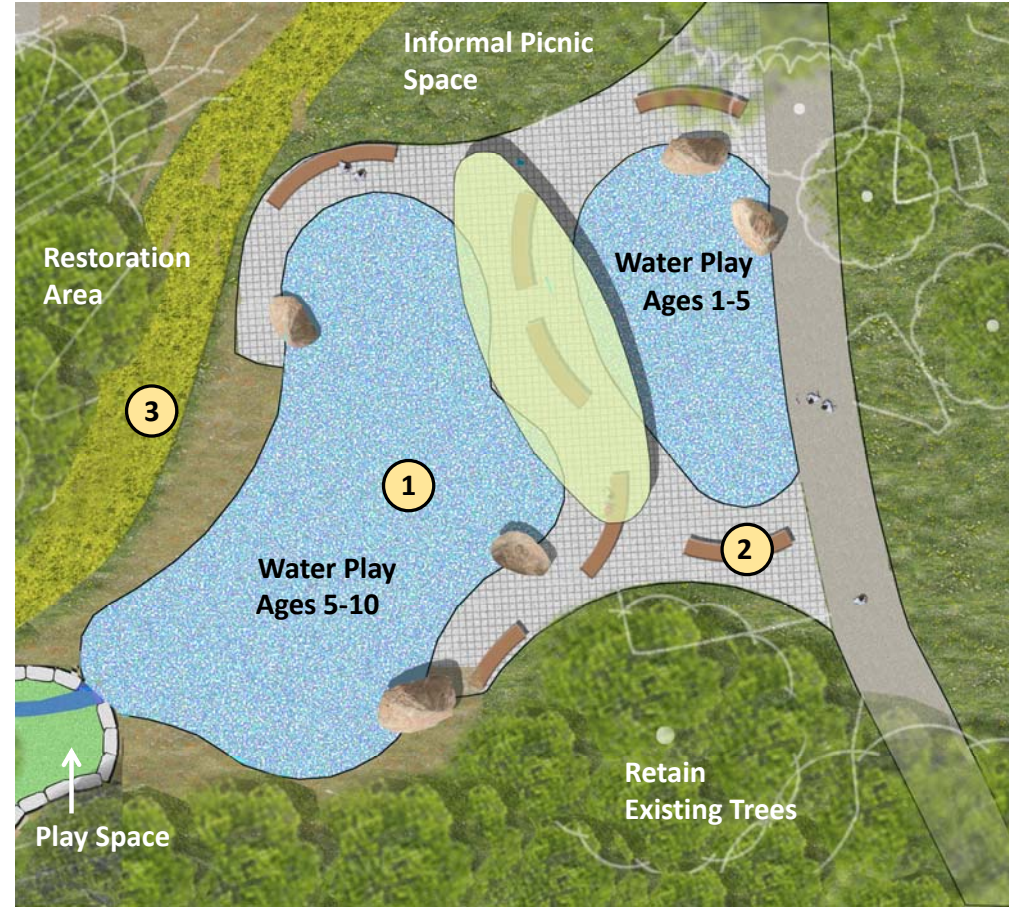

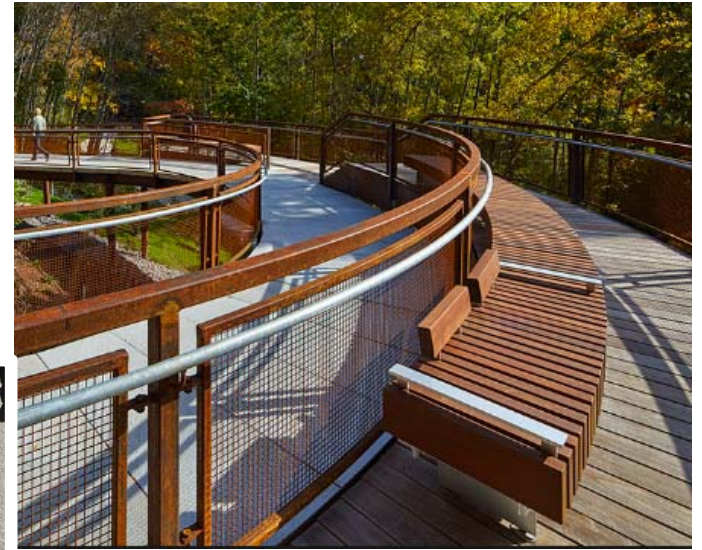

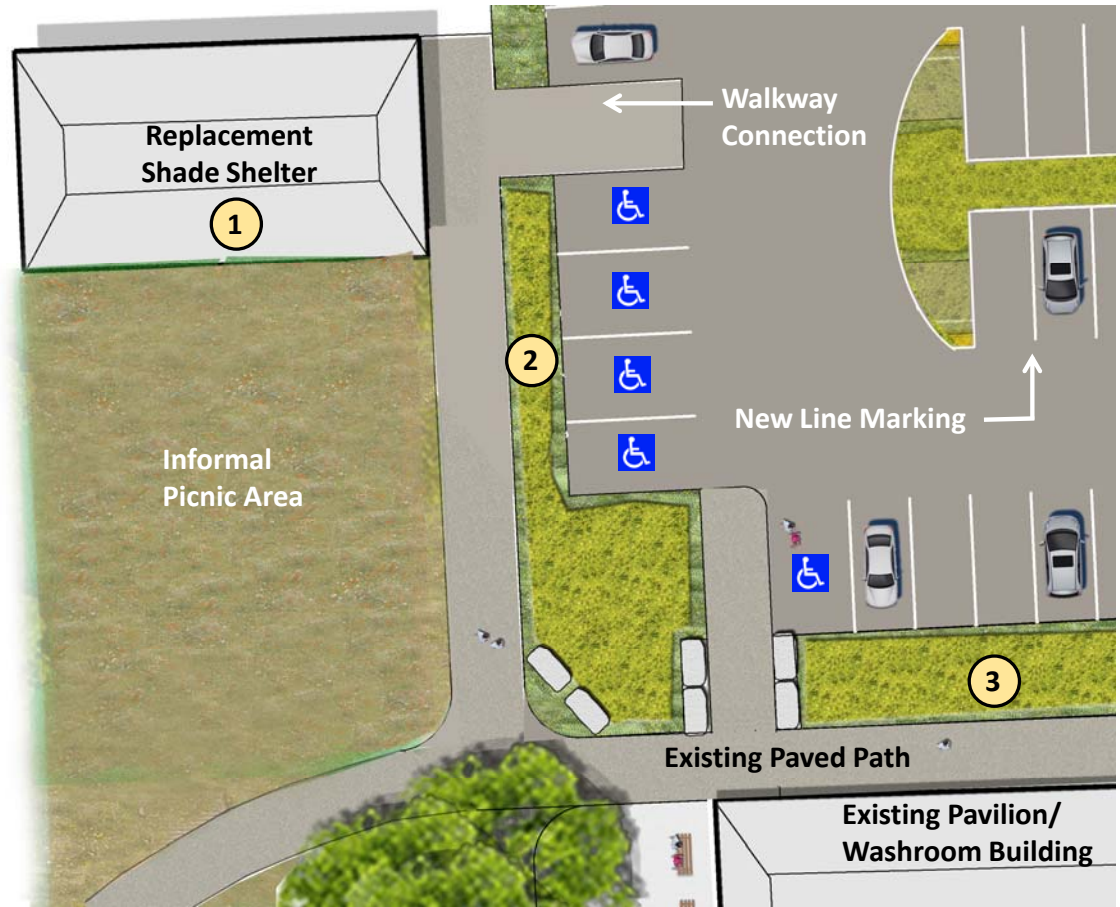

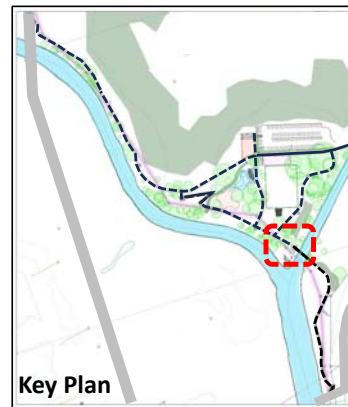

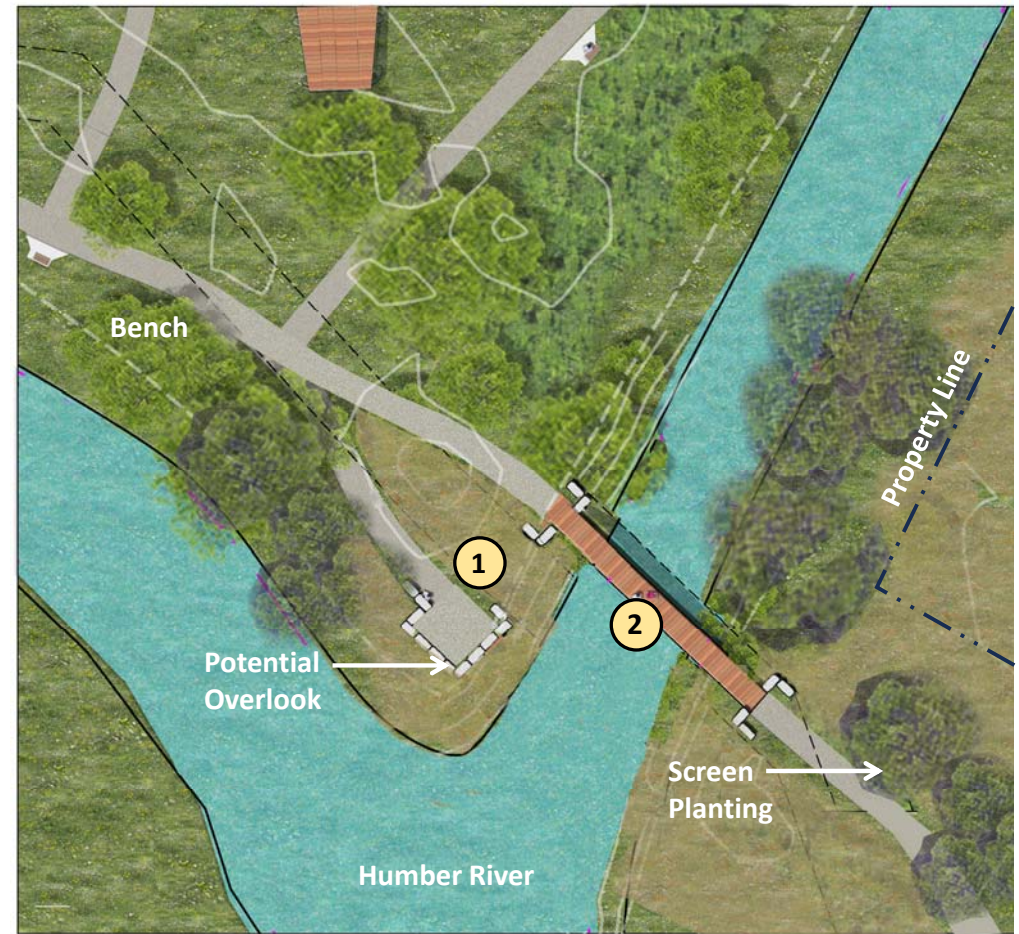

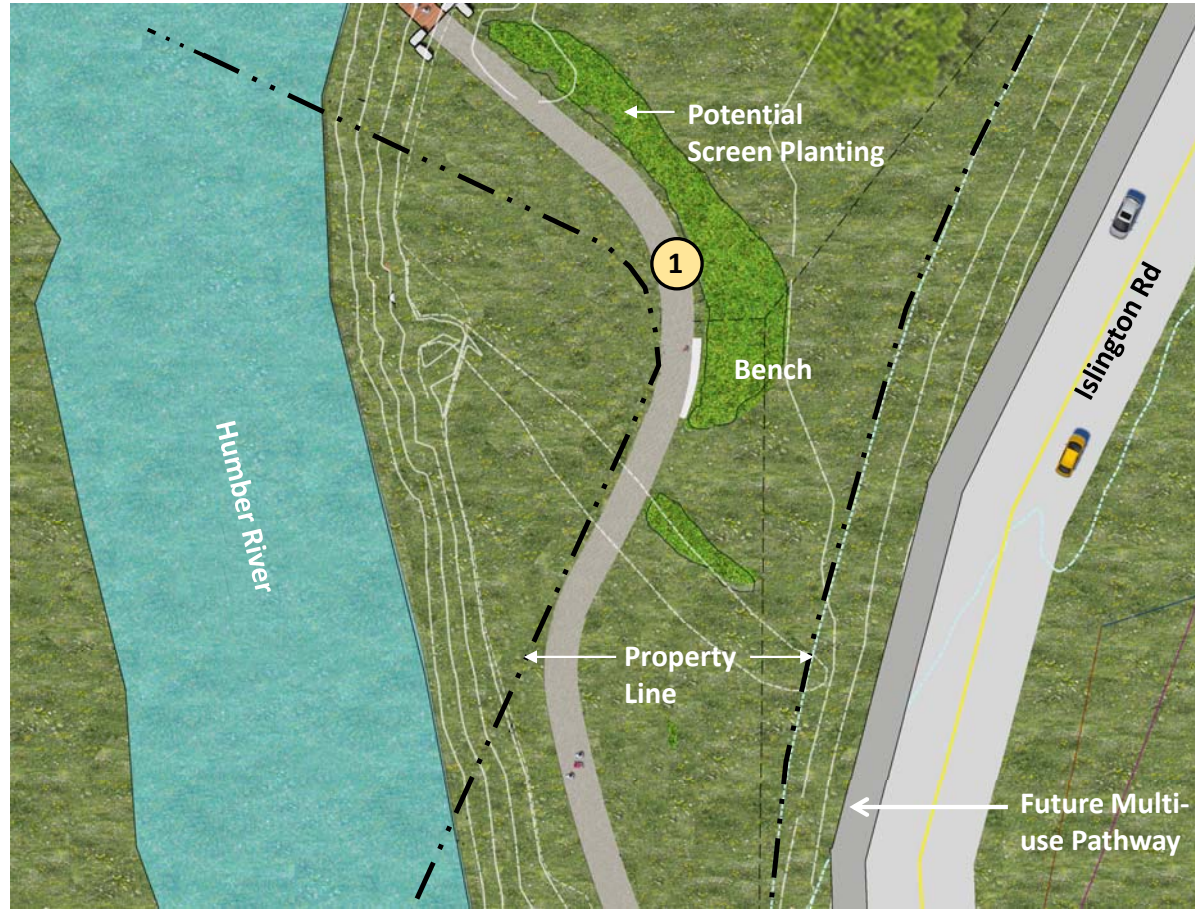

- 1 Proposed multi-use trail link between Woodbridge Avenue and Doctors McLean District Park



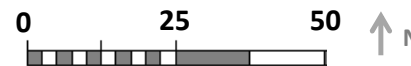
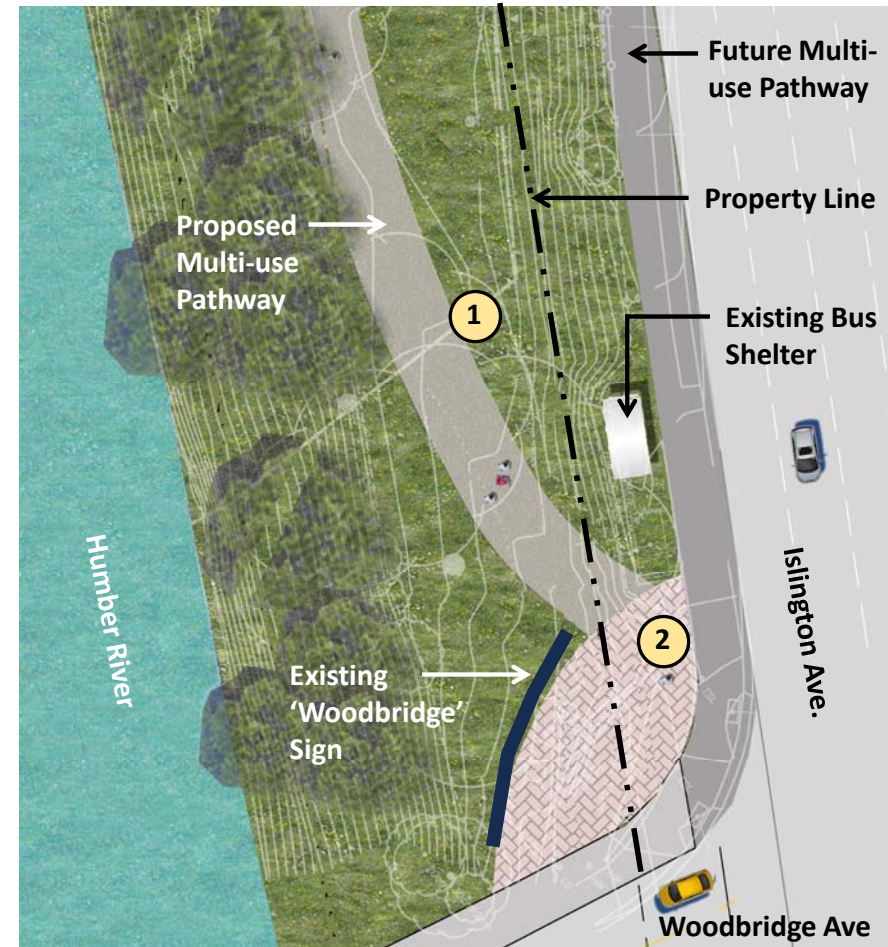

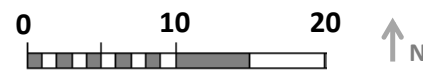

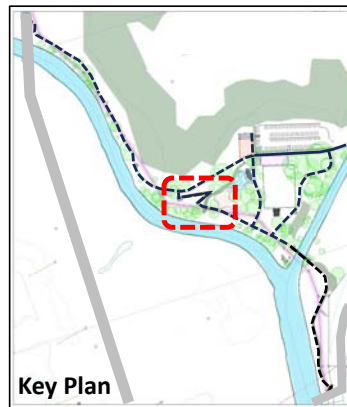
