

BOARD OF TRADE UPDATE

Pre-Construction Meeting

The pre-construction meeting has been completed. The owner and contractor were made aware of the restrictions of parking on the adjacent roadways and informed that the acceptable working times are 7am to 7pm, Monday to Friday with no work permitted on Sundays or holidays. The roadways will be maintained for cleanliness.

Update to Fill Onsite

The City and developer came to an agreement that the Fill is to be moved <u>onsite</u> to a low lying area and stockpile. This will significantly reduce the number of trucks entering and exiting the site as the fill will remain within the property. The number of trucks will vary as the work progresses, but it is expected that 3 to 5 trucks per day will be accessing the site, depending on the type of work being carried out.
