



Bass Pro Mills Drive extension

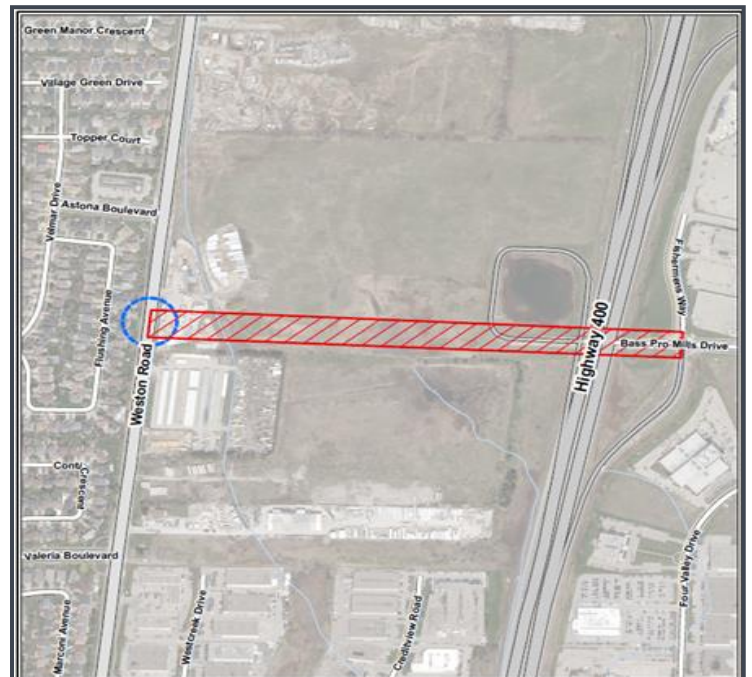
Dear resident or business owner,

The City of Vaughan has started the detailed design stage of the Bass Pro Mills Drive extension project. The Municipal Class Environmental Assessment study was completed early this year, which evaluated the need to extend Bass Pro Mills Drive, from Highway 400 to Weston Road.

Recommendations of the study include:

- providing a new east-west, multi-modal connection along Bass Pro Mills Drive, from Highway 400 and Weston Road.
- helping alleviate traffic congestion on the adjacent road network.
- supporting future growth and development within the area.
- creating new multi-modal transportation connections.
- developing a safe and comfortable environment for active transportation users.

Based on the findings of the study, the preferred design consists of a relatively straight extension of Bass Pro Mills Drive from Highway 400 to Weston Road, with a new 30-metre road that accommodates two lanes of traffic in each direction. It also includes a separated sidewalk and cycling path, a boulevard on both sides of the roadway, streetlighting and streetscaping features and more. The existing Highway 400 bridge will be modified as part of the project.



Project update

In September 2024, consulting firm, Parsons Inc., was the successful bidder for the design contract for the extension. Construction is expected to start July 2026 and be completed by 2028.

There will be some investigations and site work on the property where Bass Pro Mills will be extended.
