Notice: Overnight lane closures on Islington Avenue, from Nashville Road to Stegman's Mill Road

The City of Vaughan is installing a new watermain on Islington Avenue in Kleinburg Village. To safely complete the work, and to minimize disruptions to traffic, businesses and pedestrians, the work will be completed overnight.

Temporary lane closures will be required on Islington Avenue, from Nashville Road to Stegman's Mill Road, starting Tuesday, Oct. 22 until Friday, Nov. 15, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on weekdays.

Flag persons will be onsite to guide traffic in the area and detour signage will be in place to guide travellers through alternate routes. Access to residences and businesses along Islington Avenue will be maintained. Methods to reduce construction noise will be implemented where possible.

More about the temporary lane closures:

- Northbound and southbound traffic on Islington Avenue, from Nashville Road to Stegman's Mill Road, will be reduced to one-lane. Traffic will be directed by flag persons.
- The westbound entrance from Kellam Street to Islington Avenue will be closed during this time. Traffic will be redirected to John Street and Napier Street. Detour signage will be in place.

About the project:

The City is undertaking important infrastructure improvements within Kleinburg Village, including watermain replacements, road reconstruction work and streetscaping enhancements.
