NOTICE: Temporary road closure on Thornridge Drive, between Yonge Street and Elizabeth Street

To safely complete utility installation work for the <u>Yonge North Subway Extension</u>, a road closure on Thornridge Drive, between Yonge Street and Elizabeth Street, is required from Monday, Oct. 28 to Friday, Nov. 22, from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on weekdays. The road will be accessible for the remainder of the day.

Signage and barriers will be in place to guide travellers through the detour routes.

The purpose of the road closure is to complete the installation of concrete encased duct bank and hydro lines, to be carried out by Black and McDonald as a part of Yonge North Subway Extension project for Metrolinx. It requires trenching operations involving significant excavation along the west side of Yonge Street. This work will require heavy machinery and unsafe ground openings making it difficult to maintain safe traffic flow while work is underway.

The excavation required to accommodate the installation of these structures will render the roads impassable during construction. Based on the engineering design, a partial closure of the roadways is not possible, and thus, a full closure is requested to ensure safe installation/construction practices.

The temporary road closure is required to facilitate construction in a safe, efficient, and timely manner as well as to avoid any conflicts with underground infrastructure while using heavy machinery to complete the work.
