

THE CITY OF VAUGHAN
MAYORAL DECISION 013-2024

To delegate certain powers and obligations to the City Manager pursuant to section 284.6 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*.

Whereas, Section 284.6 of the Municipal Act, 2001 assigns to the head of council powers with respect to determining the organizational structure of the municipality and to hire, dismiss or exercise any other prescribed employment powers with respect to the head of any division or any other part of the organizational structure;

And whereas, O.Reg. 530/22 authorizes the head of council to delegate certain powers to the chief administrative officer;

Now therefore, the Mayor decides as follows:

1. That Mayoral Decision 1-2023 be repealed.
2. The City Manager shall have the authority and responsibility to hire, dismiss or exercise any other prescribed employment powers with respect to any employee other than those identified in section 6. The City Manager shall have the authority and responsibility to restructure the organization of the Corporation.
3. The City Manager may sub-delegate the authority in section 2 in writing to a City employee from time to time.
4. The City Manager shall have the authority for the organizational structure of the Corporation, until such time as it may be changed by the Mayor.
5. The City Manager Bylaw 403-2003, as amended by 012-2013, and any other employment-related bylaws, policies and directions, shall continue to apply to the extent that they do not conflict with this and any other Mayoral Decisions, or the *Municipal Act, 2001*.
6. For clarity, in accordance with section 284.6(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, this Mayoral Decision does not apply to the hiring, dismissal or exercise of any other prescribed employment powers with respect to the following positions:
 - a. The Clerk and the Deputy Clerk;
 - b. The City Treasurer and the Deputy City Treasurer;
 - c. The Chief Building Official;
 - d. The Fire Chief;
 - e. The Integrity Commissioner; and
 - f. The Lobbyist Registrar.
