Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan has completed the design for the new multi-use pathways coming to the west side of Basaltic Road and Barrhill Road in Maple. Construction is scheduled to begin in October 2024 and be complete by the end of December 2024. These multi-use pathways will replace the existing sidewalks on the west side of Basaltic Road and Barrhill Road.

What is a multi-use pathway?

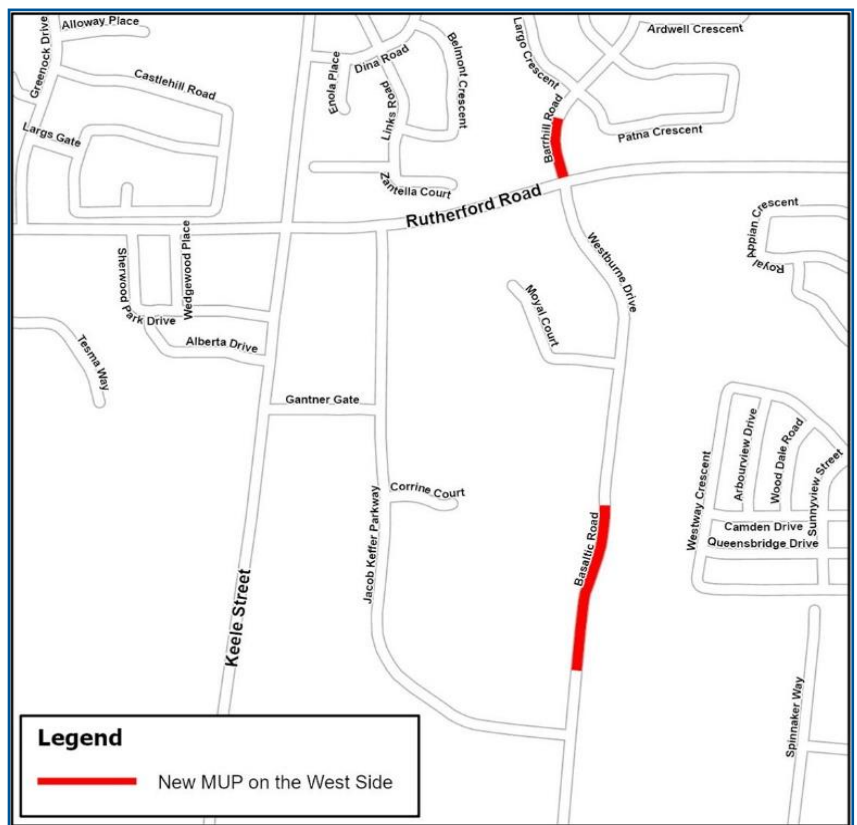
Multi-use pathways are shared spaces for people walking and riding their bikes separate from those driving. These areas are within the boulevard along a roadway.

Construction impacts

Roads will remain open to vehicles and pedestrians during construction. Temporary lane restrictions will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.
