A By-law to amend City of Vaughan By-law 001-2021, as amended.

WHEREAS the matters herein set out are in conformity with the Official Plan of the Vaughan Planning Area, which is approved and in force at this time;

AND WHEREAS there has been no amendment to the Vaughan Official Plan adopted by Council but not approved at this time, with which the matters herein set out are not in conformity;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That City of Vaughan By-law Number 001-2021, as amended, be and it is hereby further amended by:
 - a) Amending Table 6-2: Parking Requirements for All Zones by deleting the reference to "Per 4 Beds" in the "Rate Calculation" column for "Independent living facility" and "Supportive living facility" and replacing it with "Per Bedroom".

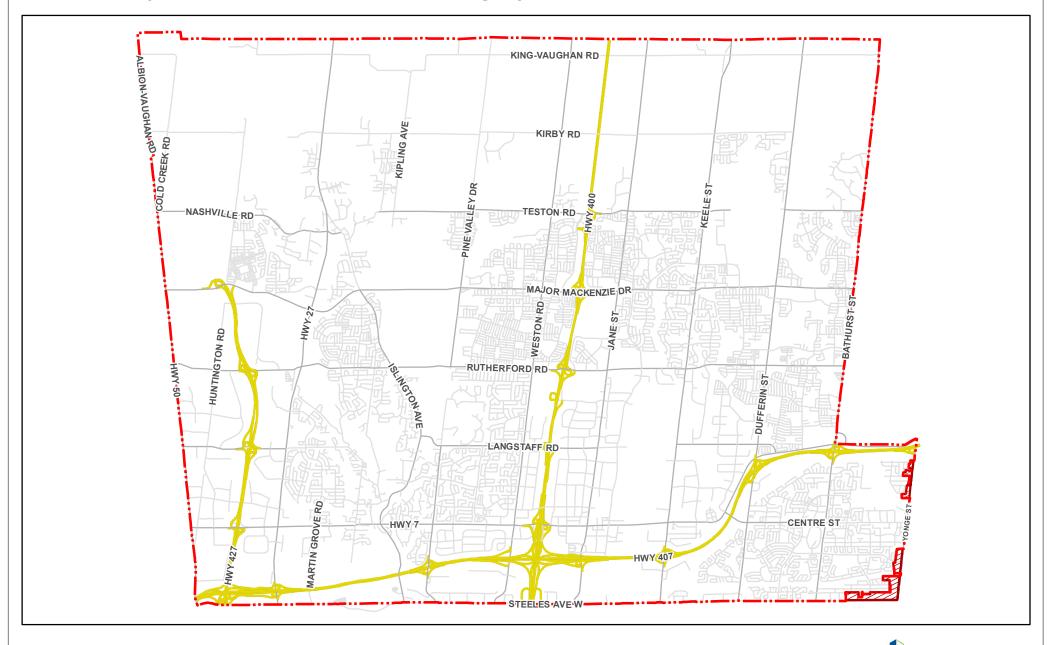

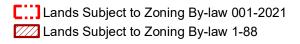
SUMMARY TO BY-LAW 199-2024

The lands subject to this By-law include all lands within the City of Vaughan, in the Regional Municipality of York, with the exception of lands in the vicinity of Yonge Street and Steeles Avenue, where By-law 001-2021 is applicable.

The purpose of this By-law is to amend City of Vaughan Comprehensive Zoning By-law 001-2021 to amend the parking requirement column of Table 6-2 for Independent Living Facility and Supportive Living Facility uses to reflect a parking rate per bedroom instead of per four (4) beds.
