

NOTICE OF DESIGNATION UNDER THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT

NOTICE

Please take notice that at its **December 17, 2024** meeting, the Council of the City of Vaughan passed the following By-law to designate the identified property as being of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest pursuant to Part IV, Section 29(8) of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.

By-law 236-2024 - 8795 Keele Street

Any person who objects to the By-law may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal by filing with the Ontario Land Tribunal and the Clerk of the City of Vaughan, a notice of appeal. The notice of appeal must set out the objection to the By-law and the reasons in support of the objection, accompanied by the Ontario Land Tribunal fee: <u>Fee Chart | Ontario Land Tribunal (gov.on.ca)</u>.

The notice of appeal must be filed 30 days after the date of publication of this Notice and can be filed online to the Ontario Land Tribunal, using their online e-filing service: <u>E-File Portal</u> <u>Ontario Land Tribunal (gov.on.ca</u>). This Notice was published on January 15, 2025.
