

Improvements Coming to Islington Avenue and Highway 7

Dear resident/business owner.

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important infrastructure improvements on Islington Avenue, from Major Mackenzie Drive to Highway 7, and on Highway 7, from Islington Avenue to Bruce Street.

Work includes:

- replacing the sidewalk on the west side of Islington Avenue, from Highway 7 to Kiloran Avenue, with a new multi-use pathway – a shared space for pedestrians and cyclists within the boulevard along the roadway.
- constructing cycle tracks on the south side of Highway 7, from Islington Avenue to Bruce Street.
- adding a new sidewalk on the south side of Arista Gate, from Islington Avenue to Islington Woods
 Court.
- upgrading streetlights on Islington Avenue.
- resurfacing the existing multi-use pathway on Islington Avenue, from Langstaff Road to Major Mackenzie Drive.
- intersection improvements at Islington Avenue and Kiloran Avenue.

Timeline

Construction is scheduled to begin this spring and be completed by the end of the year.

Driveway impacts

Work will take place on City-owned property. If you have plans to repave your driveway in 2025, please contact the City to ensure your new driveway is not damaged during construction.

Construction impacts

Roads will remain open to vehicles and pedestrians during construction, but temporary lane restrictions will be required at times to allow work to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.
