

Active Transportation Improvements

Dear resident/business owner,

New cycling infrastructure and intersection upgrades are coming to your community as part of the Pedestrian and Cycling Infrastructure Implementation Program, which supports the City of Vaughan's Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plan. The project is currently in the design stage, with construction anticipated to begin in spring 2026.

Project area

Active transportation improvements are planned for the following locations:

- District Avenue, from Peter Rupert Avenue to Dufferin Street
- Freedom Trail, from Peter Rupert Avenue to Dufferin Street
- Lealinds Road, from Petticoat Road to Peter Rupert Avenue
- Peter Rupert Avenue, from Major Mackenzie Drive to Rutherford Road
- Petticoat Road (north/south segment), from Petticoat Road to Petticoat Road
- Pleasant Ridge Avenue, from Rutherford Road to Langstaff Road
- Thomas Cook Avenue, from Major Mackenzie Drive to Valley Vista Drive
- Valley Vista Drive, from Dufferin Street to Bathurst Street

Project update

City-retained engineering consultants will be conducting the following pre-construction work:

- topographic surveys evaluation of road surfaces
- tree surveys review of tree conditions in the area
- geotechnical work drilling of boreholes and soil condition testing

Underground utilities (i.e. gas, telephone and hydro,) will be identified by coloured paint markings. All roads will remain open during pre-construction work.


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Project area map
