Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements in Ward 1 as part of the 2025 Pavement Management Program. Work will include restoring community roads and repairing curbs and sidewalks. Construction is expected to begin in May and is anticipated to be complete by November.

The following roads will be impacted:

- Charles Cooper Court
- Huntington Road, from Kirby Road to the north end of Huntington Road
- Mizuno Crescent
- Richard Lovat Court

Construction impacts

- Roads will remain open to vehicles and pedestrians during construction.
- Temporary lane restrictions will be required to allow work to proceed safely and efficiently.
- Access to private and commercial driveways and entrances will occasionally be impacted.

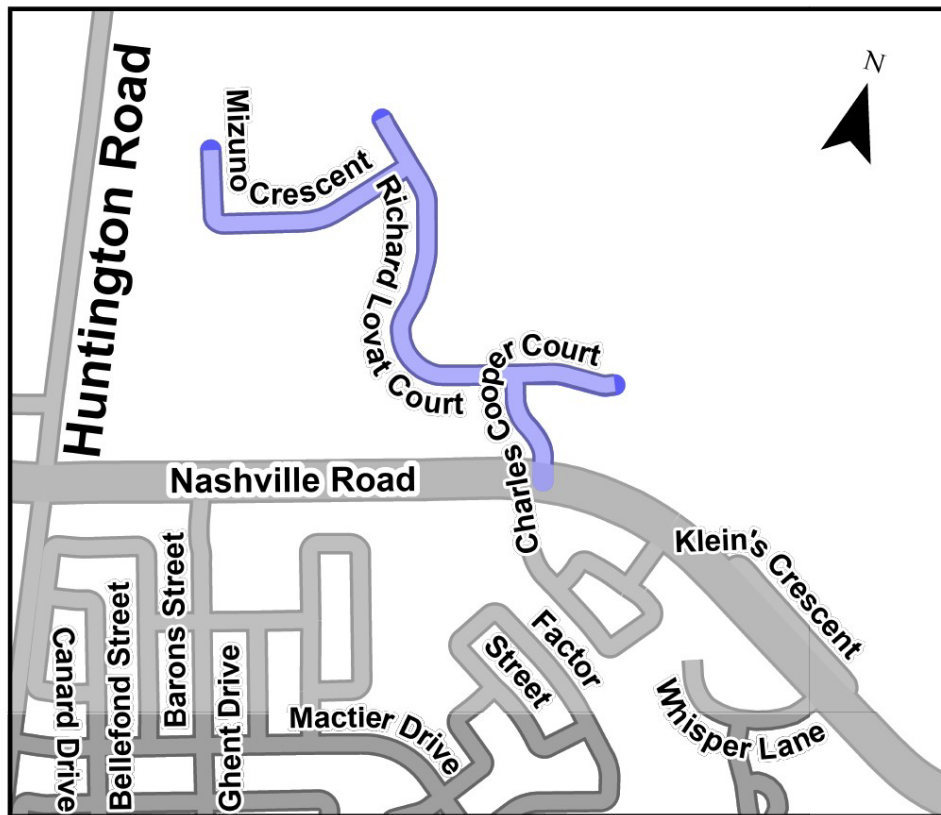
Reminders for property owners

- Under the Encroachment By-law No. 034-2017, **the City is not responsible for damage that may occur during construction to privately-owned items located on City property, including underground systems like lawn sprinklers, heated driveways and landscaping.**
- Removing privately-owned underground systems, at the owner's expense, is recommended before work begins.
- If you have landscape or driveway work planned, please contact the City's Infrastructure Delivery department at Infrastructure.Delivery@vaughan.ca to learn about the impacts the scheduled work may have.
- If your internet connection is impacted during the work, please contact your service provider to schedule a repair.
