

NOTICE REFRESHMENT VEHICLES ON CITY PROPERTY

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE (2) - Tuesday, April 8, 2025

On April 8, 2025, the City of Vaughan Committee of the Whole (2) will consider and receive input from the public on a staff report that proposes to make amendments to the City's Fees and Charges By-law 251-2024 and to the City's Business Licensing By-law 122-2022 to introduce a new permit for licensed refreshment vehicles to operate in designated spaces on City property. The proposed changes include:

- Fees and Charges By-law amendments:
 - introduction of new permit fee for refreshment vehicles on City property;
 - reduction of the existing fees for refreshment vehicles owners and drivers;
- Business Licensing By-law amendments:
 - introduction of new permit to Operate on City Property under certain conditions;
 - changes to existing requirements for refreshment vehicle operators, such as: criminal background checks, additional fire safety requirements, prohibition from selling alcohol, tobacco or cannabis products.
