BY-LAW NUMBER 041-2024

A By-law to assume Municipal Services in respect of Registered Plan 65M- 4488.


WHEREAS the subdivision agreement between The Corporation of the City of Vaughan (the “City”) and Glen-Huntington Business Park Limited dated April 24, 2015, provides for the construction and installation of certain municipal services on the lands shown on Schedule “A” of this by-law and related to Registered Plan 65M-4488 (the “Subdivision Agreement”).

AND WHEREAS the Deputy City Manager of Infrastructure Development has received certification that the municipal services set out in the Subdivision Agreement have been constructed and installed in accordance with the City’s specifications.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Voted in favour by City of Vaughan Council this 26th day of March, 2024.



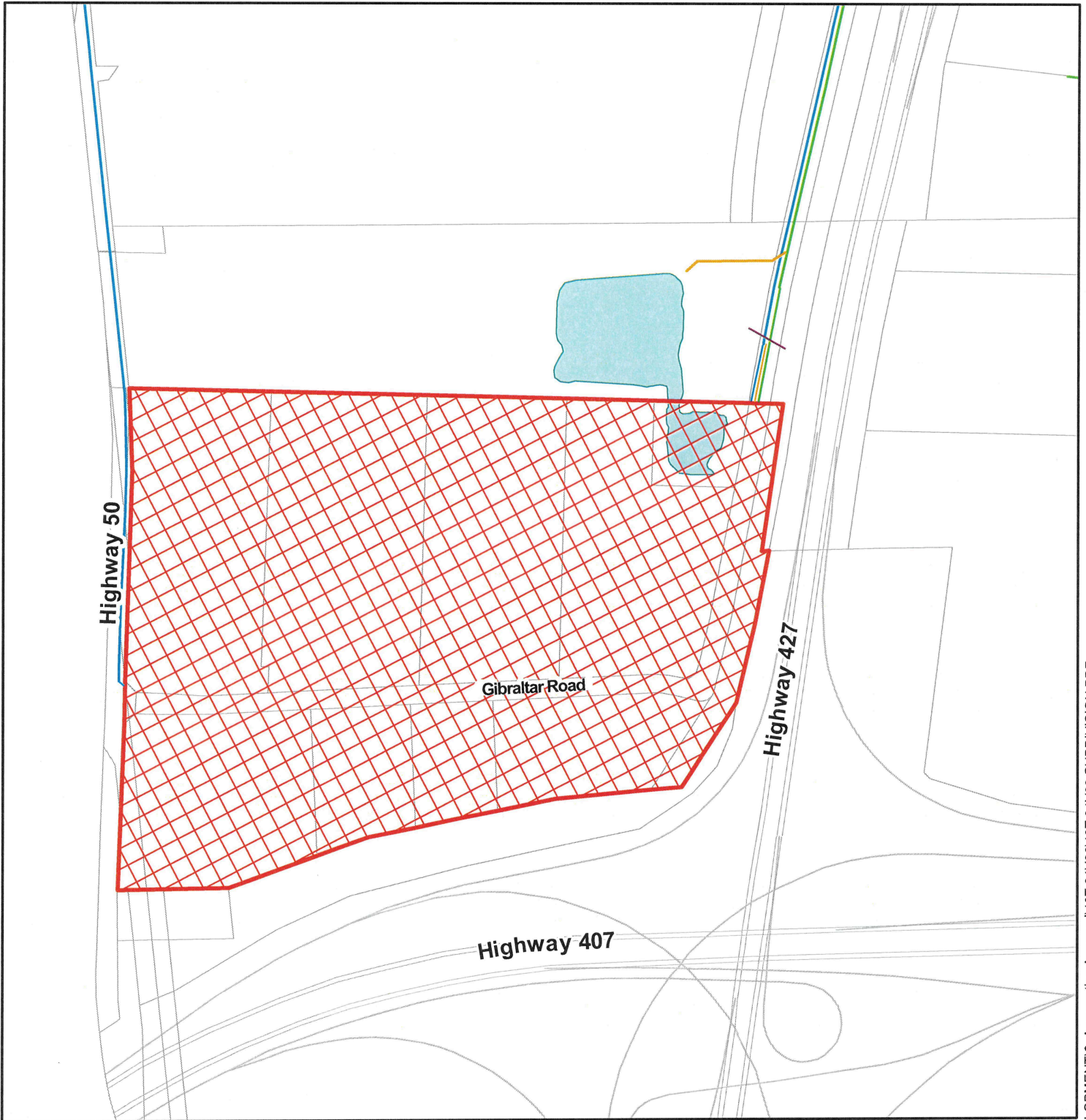
