Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements in Ward 1 as part of the 2025 Pavement Management Program. Work will include restoring community roads and repairing curbs and sidewalks. Construction is expected to begin in May and is anticipated to be completed by November 2025.

The following roads will be impacted:

- Charles Cooper Court
- Huntington Road, from Kirby Road to the north end of Huntington Road
- Mizuno Crescent
- Richard Lovat Court

Frequently asked questions

The contractor installed new sod on my lawn. Who is responsible for the maintenance?

The contractor is responsible for watering and maintaining the new sod. However, you are encouraged to water it as frequently as possible to ensure root growth and healthy green grass.

My driveway is blocked due to the work. Will I get a parking ticket if I park on the roadway?

The City's By-law department has been notified of the upcoming construction and staff have been instructed not to issue tickets. However, if you are parked contrary to regulations of the City's Parking By-law 064-2019, you could be ticketed. For more information visit vaughan.ca/bylaw.

Reminders for property owners

- Under the Road Allowance By-Law 126-2024, the City is not responsible for damage that may
 occur during construction to privately-owned items located on City property, including
 underground systems like lawn sprinklers, heated driveways and landscaping.
- Removing privately-owned underground systems, at the owner's expense, is recommended before work begins.
- If you have landscape or driveway work planned, please contact the City's Infrastructure Delivery department at lnfrastructure.Delivery@vaughan.ca to learn about the impacts the scheduled work may have.






- If your internet connection is impacted during the work, please contact your service provider to schedule a repair.
